

GDP: US\$ 1.68 trillion; Population: 25.98 million (net migration increasing); 3.6% unemployment (steady). AUD/USD: 0.66 – trending downwards



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Main Trades & Partners

Raw materials incl. iron ore, coal, gas, gold, and wheat – rare earths / critical minerals on the rise. Main trading partners being China, Japan, USA, Korea...



BHP Port Debottlenecking Project 1

NMT were engaged by FLSmidth to manage the transport of a reclaimer from Henderson (Fremantle) to Canyon G Site at Port Hedland.

- 1 shipment consisting 20,000 RT of Modules
- Max lift 300mt; max length 50+ metres
- Scope incl. delivery ex factory to alongside vessel; ocean transport, delivery from under ship's hook to project site via port laydown
- 6 months project planning / management
